

## PARATY

Paraty is a beautiful colonial city considered a World Heritage Site and, along with Ilha Grande, registered as a Mixed Heritage Site (the first in Brazil), recognized for both its cultural and natural aspects. The city preserves, until nowadays, its countless natural and architectural charms. Walking through the Historic Center of Paraty is like entering another era. In the eighteenth century, it was an important port through which drained gold and precious stones of Minas Gerais to be shipped to Portugal. However, the constant pirate's assaults who took refuge in close beaches, changed the gold route leading the city to a great economic isolation. Around the 70's, due to easier access through a new road, Paraty has become a more touristic place due to its history, beautiful nature and landscape.

### DAY 1 – July 13th, Sunday – IN / PARATY - Historical Walking Tours

Upon arrival in São Paulo Airport, meet your guide and be transferred to Paraty in a private vehicle. The route takes approximately 4 to 6 hours, depending on traffic conditions. Around 4pm, meet your local guide and depart for a Historical Walking Tour. Overnight in Paraty.

Historical Walking Tour (1h30-2h): With one of our local hosts walk the historic old town of Paraty, a UNESCO nominated World Heritage site. Beautiful colonial architecture, street design ahead of its time, exiled Portuguese royalty and the dark past of the slave trade – these are just some of the ingredients that make Paraty history rich and colorful from the past to the present day.

Note: On Mondays some attractions can be closed.

**DAY 2 – July 14th, Monday – PARATY – Schooner Tour (B)** After breakfast, meet your guide at your hotel and walk towards the pier to depart on a private schooner tour around Paraty's Bay. Return to your hotel. Overnight in Paraty.

**Schooner Tour (5h):** Paraty is surrounded by lush rain forest vegetation. The bay is an unforgettable place with its crystalline water, perfect for swimming and snorkeling. Stops on islands or remote beaches will be made along the program. Lunch (not included) can be made at a local beach restaurant.

**Please note:** Wear your swimsuit under your clothing; bring a towel, sunscreen, hat and bottled water. Fruits, Stand-up Paddle, and an individual snorkel kit will be available on the schooner.

**DAY 3 – July 15th, Tuesday – PARATY – Gold Trail Tour (B)**  
After breakfast, meet your guide at your hotel and depart on a private Gold Trail Tour.

**Gold / Cachaça distillery / Rain Forest Tour Trail I 5–6h**

Experience Paraty's unique combination of history, culture and nature on this fascinating tour in the forest on the mountainside behind the town. With your expert local guide, step back in time on the Gold Trail, the paved road built by African slaves in the 18th Century to bring gold and precious stones out of the Brazilian interior and onto ships to Portugal. The guide will also trace the development of Paraty through the sugar, gold and coffee economic booms. After walking on the trail through the rainforest you will stop at freshwater pools and waterfalls for a refreshing swim.

You'll also visit the thrilling Toboggan waterfall, a natural rock waterslide that you can slide down safely and the locals 'surf' down standing up! From the Falls, visit a cachaça distillery and taste the various types of cachaça. Visit Bananal Farm, a tranquil and beautiful place surrounded by nature that aims to preserve and educate for a sustainable future, and where it is possible to enjoy a farm-to-table lunch (not included - please check the quote). Wear comfortable walking shoes, a hat and a swimsuit, bring towel, water, snacks, sunscreen and insect repellent.

Level of difficulty: Easy/moderate. Walking up to 1h30 with breaks (roundtrip) downhill on uneven surfaces.

**DAY 4 – July 16th, Wednesday – PARATY – Free Day (B)**  
Enjoy a free day exploring Paraty at your own leisure. Overnight in Paraty.

**DAY 5 – July 17th, Thursday – PARATY / OUT (B)**

At the appropriate time, check-out and meet your guide at your hotel to be transferred in a private vehicle to the airport. The route takes approximately 4 to 6 hours, depending on traffic conditions.
